#### **Translators' Education Programmes**

Skill development of translators is one of the focus areas of National Translation Mission. The Mission offers training to translators in the form of Intensive Programme and Orientation Programme. It also offers academic support to professional translators. Efforts are on to offer Certificate and Diploma courses in Translation.

# 2-Week Intensive Training Programme

**Who should attend?** This programme is for those who translate as a hobby or wish to build a career as a translator. It is also for professional translators and Translation Studies students who want to enhance their knowledge and improve their skills. The participants usually include (a) Early career employees and students registered in various universities/institutions, (b) Language officers working in different government and semi-government set-ups, (c) persons involved in CSTT activities, etc.

**Where?** The training and orientation programmes will be held at the National Translation Mission, Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore.
