A Detail Report On Shortlisted books for Translation

INTRODUCTION

This is a report on the books selected for translation by NTM. As per the suggestions received in the Second Project Advisory Committee Meeting of NTM, some of the common disciplines of higher education (Economics, History, Law, Philosophy, Mathematics, Mechanical Engineering and Sociology) were included to the 8 disciplines (Political Science, Psychology, Botany, Computer Science, Physics, Medical Science, Zoology and Chemistry) in which the Subcommittee had approved books in the second meeting held on 13th February, 2010.

The methodology adopted by NTM to arrive at the book lists: NTM contacted experts in each disciplines and the list of books were collected from them. The lists were consolidated and books that were common to all the lists were extracted. The status of these books in the NTM Indian Universities Database was checked. For instance, *Masters of Sociological Thought: Ideas in Historical and Social Context* by Coser was a book suggested by all the experts in Sociology. The book was found to have been prescribed about 34 times in the Indian Universities Database under various courses of universities across the country. Teachers, Students and other experts of the disciplines from various language backgrounds were contacted next to get an opinion of the demand for these books in the regional languages. After consolidating all the information, books that would benefit the students and the academia most have been shortlisted for translation by NTM. This list was placed before NTM-PAC and Subcommittee on Knowledge Books to be translated. This is a report of the 47 titles that were approved by the same.

The report is structured in the following way: Under each discipline, a note from the University Grants Commission's report (UGC Report, here onwards) on the Medium of Instruction/Writing Exams (MoI, here onwards) has been given with the table mentioning the kinds of courses and the regional languages used in Indian Universities. This is followed by observation from the Knowledge Text Scenario Survey (NTM Survey, here onwards) about the disciplines and the existing knowledge texts available in the regional languages either as original or as translations. Details of the books shortlisted appear next. There is a mention of the status of availability of the books in Indian languages as translation. A paragraph consolidating the salient opinions on the books available from the feedback reports is given next. A table showing the various undergraduate and postgraduate courses in which the books have been prescribed in the universities is also given. This is followed by a list of all the books suggested by experts contacted for the discipline.

BOTANY

UGC Report: As per the UGC report, it is recorded that 13 Universities are offering Botany courses with Indian languages as medium of instruction. Hindi leads the table with eight universities, Bengali follows with two and Gujarati, Kannada and Marathi have one each (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey (KTS Survey) done by NTM shows that none of the suggested Botany books are available in translations in Indian Languages. There are original writings related to Botany subjects in Kannada (19), Bengali (4) and Hindi (03). The books available in Kannada language focus on the general aspects of Botany. Some of these books are used at pre-university level.

Books Suggested for Translation:

BOOK 1

Salisbury.F B. and Ross C. W Plant Physiology CBS Publishers and Distributors, 2007

NTM Database status: 15 times

Book description excerpts: The text provides a broad explanation of the physiology for plants (their functions) from seed germination to vegetative growth, maturation, and flowering. There are four major sections. The first covers cell structure, water relations, mineral nutrition, ion uptake and phloem transport. The second deals with enzyme action, photosynthesis, respiration, assimilation of nitrogen and sulphur, lipids and various plant products. Although this section is entitled 'Plant Biochemistry', it also incorporates a chapter on the carbon cycle and environmental aspects of photosynthesis. The third section, 'Plant Development', contains growth, morphogenesis, hormones movements, rhythms and responses to lights and temperature. The final section is briefer, of two chapters only, on 'Environmental Physiology'.

BOOK 2

De Robertis, E. D. P. and De Robertis, E.M.F. *Cell and Molecular Biology* Lippincott Williams and Wilkins, 2008

Book description excerpts: This book offers an interesting viewpoint about cell biology.

CHEMISTRY

UGC Report: There are a total of 13 universities in India which offer Chemistry courses in regional languages. Out of the 25 such courses, 21 are postgraduate courses. PhD in Chemistry can be done through Hindi in six universities and through Bengali and Gujarati in one each (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Faculty and students alike from different parts of the country have demanded translation of Chemistry books from NTM. Academics from Andhra Pradesh, Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur and Tamil Nadu have expressed their desire to have Chemistry books in their respective regional languages. Books shortlisted by NTM also figure among the list of books that the respondents wanted to read in translation. Both the students and the faculty from Andhra Pradesh have requested for the translation of *Cotton and Wilkinson; Finar I and II* have been mentioned by students from Hindi speaking areas and faculty and students from Tamil Nadu. Students from Manipur and Tamil Nadu have asked NTM to make *Banwell* available in translation.

Chemistry books originally written in or translated into regional languages have been found mostly in Hindi (eight originals and five translations). In fact, two Hindi translations were found prescribed in the university curriculum. State Institute of Languages, Kerala has published nine books in Malayalam and one of them is a translation. A publisher from Andhra Pradesh pointed out that compilations of 300 question-answers for two mark questions in Chemistry were available in the market. The publishers said that students in rural areas and others who spend a lot of time going through these question banks would be benefitted by NTM translations.

BOOK 1

Cotton F., Albert; Wilkinson, Geoffrey; Carlos A. Murillo; Manfred Bochmann *Advanced Inorganic Chemistry: A Comprehensive Text* Wiley India, 2007

NTM Database status: Over 50 times

Book description excerpts: Advanced Inorganic Chemistry has been the standard textbook for half a century in the subject. It examines cluster chemistry, homogeneous catalysis and, in particular, organometallic chemistry which led to a fundamental shift in the way in which inorganic chemistry was studied. A closer focus on the molecular structure of compounds is attributed as an effect of this work in Chemistry.

BOOK 2

Finar, I. L. Organic Chemistry (volume I) Pearson Education, 2002 (6th ed)

NTM Database status: Over 57 times

Finar, I. L. *Organic Chemistry* (volume II) Pearson Education, 2002 (5th ed)

NTM Database status: Over 50 times

Book description excerpts: *Organic Chemistry* is a well-established two-volume textbook for students studying chemistry at degree level. The aim to describe the fundamental principles is well accomplished in the presentation of a comprehensive treatment of organic chemistry in terms of modern concepts. The author presents in concise style, fundamental organic chemistry in the traditional pattern (atomic structure, aliphatics, alicyclics, aromatics, and heterocvolics) in the light of electronio interpretations and reaction mechanisms. Volume 2 carries the material of Volume 1: Fundamental Principles to a more advanced level. The author provides a comprehensive introduction to the relationship between physical properties and chemical structures, and then proceeds to a detailed account of stereochemistry. The later chapters of the second volume are devoted to the most typical compounds of natural products and the problems involved.

BOOK 3

Banwell, Collin M. Fundamentals of Molecular Spectroscopy McGraw Hill, 2010

NTM Database status: 86 times

Book description excerpts: Fundamentals of Molecular Spectroscopy remains an elementary and non-mathematical introduction to molecular spectroscopy that emphasizes the overall unity of the subject and offers a pictorial perception rather than a mathematical description of the principles of spectroscopy. Heavily illustrated with many new, clear modern diagrams, the revision retains non-mathematical and easily understandable style of the original. A new chapter has been added on spectroscopy of surfaces and solids in the revised version.

BOOK 4

Atkins, Peter; De Paula, Julio *Atkins' Physical Chemistry* Oxford University Press, 2009

NTM Database status: 64 times

NTM Survey: The book, *Atkins' Physical Chemistry*, has been demanded in translation by faculty from Hindi speaking areas and students from Manipur.

Book description excerpts: The book epitomises the benchmark of achievement for a chemistry degree throughout the world. Its broad coverage, concise explanations, and robust mathematical support are clearly presented in an engaging style to furnish students with a solid foundation in the subject.

BOOK 5

Morrison, R.T. and Boyd, R.N. *Organic Chemistry*Prentice Hall of India, 2003

NTM Database status: 47 times

Book Description: In this classic introductory text, the authors aim to identify the new concepts of organic chemistry, to select the ones that are clearly fundamental to the learning of organic chemistry, and then to build them into a framework of the book. The cornerstone of this framework is that chemical behavior is determined by molecular structure. Each topic is presented fully and clearly at a level appropriate for beginning students. The authors emphasize relationships between the seemingly unrelated facts and theories that students are learning in order to reveal the broad and complex pattern underlying organic chemistry. Where possible, they lead the students to find the pattern themselves, by working problems.

None of these books have been translated into regional languages of India.

Experts' Feedback (on the first two books):

Both are very good textbooks of organic and inorganic chemistry covering all the essential components of chemistry in a simple manner. These books are presented in such a way that it will fill the gap between school book and the honors degree chemistry texts. Above all these are easy to read and understand. The initiative taken by National Translation Mission to translate is a welcome thing. I am sure that the readers will definitely be benefited from the translated version of the following two books.

Both the books received positive feedbacks by experts across the country. This was expected as the NTM database showed them to be among the most prescribed books in India. Experts even from languages like Maithili said that the books would be of help to students if they are translated. One of them, Prof. K.P. Elango of Gandhigram Rural University, Tamil Nadu expressed a little skepticism and commented that the books may be more useful to the teacher than the students.

The experts suggested that the book *Organic Chemistry* by Morrison and Boyd should be selected instead of *Finar Vol* 2 as Morrison and Boyd has recently updated content. The book *Organic Chemistry* by Morrison and Boyd has been found prescribed both in undergraduate and postgraduate courses and across the country.

Experts suggested that the book, *Atkins' Physical Chemistry*, can be chosen over Puri and Sharma's *Principle's of Physical Chemistry*, another book prescribed widely, as the former is better in content and form. The book has been prescribed both in undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

The five books selected by experts cover four major branches of the discipline of Chemistry, namely, Organic, Inorganic, Physical and Spectroscopy and Instrumental Analysis. A brief look at Table 2 from Indian Universities reveals that the five books selected for translation cover a wide range of Chemistry courses (B.Sc Chemistry, Pharmaceutical, Analytical, Instrumental, Polymer etc) and are prescribed in various universities spanning the length and breadth of the country. The books are prescribed in Central Universities, NITs etc and also regional universities like Kumaun and Kannur Universities. *Banwell* (1966), in particular, has been prescribed across disciplines. The book is part of courses in Physics, Applied Physics, Chemistry, Applied Chemistry, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Engineering, Computer Science etc.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

UGC Report: According to the UGC report, Computer Science & related courses are offered in Hindi by eleven universities. The 24 courses that are offered in Hindi range from Diploma (six) to PhD (three). Gujarati, Marathi and Tamil are the other languages in which universities (one in each) offer Computer Science courses (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey (KTS Survey) by NTM shows that in most of the languages, even general Computer Science books are not available. The total number of Computer Science books published in Kannada is about 25. The number is 11 in Marathi. In Andhra Pradesh, the Telugu Academy established in 1968 has produced 5 books so far in Computer Science. All these are original writings. In the case of Sanskrit, papers on Computer Science were introduced in the language in Sri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishwavidyalay. The courses had to be scratched after a while as there were no textbooks available.

A slightly different picture is available in case of Tamil where about 140 books, both originals and translations were found published related to Computer Science. Their focus range from basic introduction, internet, etc to computer languages like C, C++ and ASP. The latter are distributed with an accompanying CD. However, the style of presentation and the language of the books show that they are aimed at the general public like owners of internet centres than a university student.

The books are not available in translations in Indian languages.

Experts' Feedback: An opinion from Andhra Pradesh regarding Computer Science was that translations of basic/general computer books, for instance, introducing internet are needed rather than the strictly academic ones. Feedback from experts across the country on the books selected for translation was a mixed one. All of them welcomed the idea of translations into the regional languages and agreed that the books selected were important publications in Computer Science. They also commented on how the terminologies should be translated without losing accuracy and how the language should create interest for computers among the readers etc. However, most of them felt that the selected books would be of help more to the PG students than to the UG students.

Searching in NTM-Indian Universities Database, one would find that *Aho et al* (1976) book in fact has been prescribed in 13 undergraduate courses though it is prescribed more at the postgraduate level (about 20 times). The database shows that 22 Universities in total from 10 states have prescribed the *Aho et al* (1976) [Table 2] in various courses. *Knuth* (1972) was also found prescribed in the MA Linguistics course of University of Mysore.

HISTORY

UGC Database: According the UGC report on Medium of Instruction (MoI) in Indian universities, History is taught through Hindi in Thirty Four universities. The courses offered range from Diploma (seven) to PhD (25). The other regional languages through which History is taught are Kannada (6 univ), Gujarati (5 univ), Marathi (5 univ), Bengali (4 univ), Tamil (2 univ), Malayalam and Telugu one each (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey (KTS Survey) by NTM shows that few Indian languages have books in History which is either original writing or translation. The total number of History books published in Hindi is around two hundred out of which some translations are also available like *A History of Ancient and Early Medieval India: From the Stone Age to the 12th century* by Upinder Singh, *A History of South India* by K A Nilkanta Sastri, etc. In Telugu there are nineteen books available (original writings); in Marathi there are one hundred and ninety books (original) available, in Malayalam there are twenty three original texts available and two are translations. Nepali is used as a medium of instruction in various colleges in Darjeeling dist. of West Bengal in undergraduate level but there is not a single book available in Nepali for History either in original or in translation.

EXPERTS' FEEDBACK: It has been observed that among the existing books in regional languages like Hindi, Telugu Kannada, etc. on History, the books are mostly original writings and few are translations. But these are mostly general books for the masses which does not meet the requirements of academic purpose.

Most of the discipline experts have expressed their happiness on the very idea of translating these books in regional languages. *Early India: From the Origins to AD 1300* by Romila Thapar is a seminal book that should be translated into various regional languages. The experts have also suggested that terminologies should be translated without losing accuracy. However, most of them felt that the selected books would be of help more to the UG students than for the PG students.

MATHEMATICS

UGC Report: According to UGC report on MOI, various courses in Mathematics ranging from U.G to Ph.D (UG 1, PG 10, M.Phil 1, Ph.D 4) are offered in Hindi as the medium of instruction in 6 universities across the country. Gujarati and Bengali are the other languages used as MOI for Mathematics (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Original writing on Mathematics in regional languages is increasing in number. Only state bodies like State Institute of Language, Kerala; Orissa State Text Book Bureau, Orissa and Telugu Academy, Andhra Pradesh have translated some of the books in Mathematics. In the survey done by NTM, the faculty and students in some universities requested the book *Linear Algebra* to be translated into Hindi language. It is viewed from the KT survey report that many publishers are publishing books in Mathematics that are of general interest but not the text books used in colleges and universities.

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING

UGC Report: Mechanical Engineering is offered in two universities where the MoI is Hindi which include two UG courses, one PG course and a Ph D. None of the other languages offer Mechanical Engineering in the regional language according to the data. There are other 2 universities which have engineering and other courses in general with Hindi and Bengali as the MoI for PG courses (*see Table 1*)

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey (KTS Survey) by NTM shows that more than 9 books are published on general Mechanical Engineering in Kannada. In Malayalam 2 books are published wherein one is the original and the other is a translation.

Though books are published in other regional languages for Mechanical Engineering, they are usually general books and not specified to any course or study material. In the survey conducted by NTM we have found that there is a need for translation of these disciplines in various languages like Telugu, Santali etc. The translations are expected to have proper terminologies which are simple and familiar to the students rather than classical terminologies.

MEDICAL SCIENCES

UGC Report: Medical Science is offered in 3 universities with Hindi as the MoI and in one university with Tamil as the MoI. Eleven courses are being offered at different levels (Diploma=Two; UG=Three; PG=Four; PhD=One & others=One) with Hindi as the MoI. Three UG courses and one Ph.D. is offered in a university with Tamil as the MoI. Other courses concerned to Medical Sciences like Ayurveda, Physiotherapy, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Homeopathy are offered in different regional languages, but the courses do not belong to the main stream of Medical Sciences. The varied MoI for these courses are Hindi, Marathi, Tibetan, Tamil and Sanskrit. Marathi and Hindi are the MoI in 2 different universities, Sanskrit, Tibetan and Tamil are the MoI in 1 university each for Ayurveda course. Hindi is also the MoI in 2 universities for Pharmacy and 1 university for Dentistry and Homeopathy.

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey by NTM shows that 24 books have been published in Bengali language that are original and 36 books are published in Hindi of which 25 are original and 11 are translations. In Kannada more than 38 books have been published under various publications for Medical Sciences. In Konkani speaking areas, around seventy books related to Medicine, Health science, Yoga etc., are available in 4 scripts namely Devnagari, Roman, Kannada and Malayalam. These are originally published and two translations are also available.

Like most of the translations for science and technical subject, Medical Science is also in demand and translation is welcome in regional languages. Since students from rural areas are also studying Medical Science, translations of English books have become necessary.

PHILOSOPHY

UGC Database: According to the UGC report, Philosophy courses are offered in nineteen universities where the MoI is Hindi. The courses offered range from Diploma (four) to D Lit (two). Other languages that follow Hindi are Kannada (3 univ), Marathi (2 univ), Bengali (2 univ), Gujarati and Malayalam one each (*See Table 1*).

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey by NTM shows that there are Philosophy books available in Indian Languages and many of them are original writings and few are translations. *An Introduction to Philosophical Analysis* by John Hospers is translated into Bengali. *Hundred years of Philosophy* by John Passmore is available in Hindi. But most of the books suggested by experts to NTM for translation are not translated into any of the Indian languages. Experts of different languages opine that, all technical terminologies should be retained in original form while giving the equivalent terms in regional languages.

PHYSICS

The UGC Report: The UGC report reveals the fact that 18 different courses of Physics are offered with Hindi as the MoI at nine universities in the country. Two universities offer three Physics courses in Bengali and one university offers a Physics course in Gujarati language in the country (*see Table 1*).

NTM Survey: The survey undertaken by NTM shows that not many Physics books have been published in Indian languages either in original or in translated form. Some general books on the discipline have been published in languages like Hindi, Malayalam, Tamil, Kannada etc. To name few important translated Physics texts — *Fundamentals of Physics* has been translated into Punjabi, Telugu and Oriya by the state bodies like Telugu Academy, Orissa State Text Book Bureau. Orissa Sate Text Book Bureau has also brought out the translated versions of *Fundamental of Optics* by F.A. Jenkins and H.E. White for B.Sc. students. It has also produced original writings on Physics like *Aadhunika Padartha Bigyan* etc. In Hindi, around 50, mostly original writings, have been published in Physics. Although there has not been a general trend to produce and translate books of Physics in Indian languages, interaction with students and faculty across the country has clearly shown the need for such texts.

POLITICAL SCIENCE

UGC Report: There are thirty five (35) universities where Political Science is taught in eighty eight (88) courses in regional languages as stated by UGC report. The courses offered are Diploma (2), UG (9), PG (33), M. Phil. (17), Ph. D. (24), D. Litt. (2) and others (1). Among these thirty-five universities, there are twenty-two (22) universities where MoI for Political Science is Hindi. Apart from Hindi, other regional languages which are MoI for Political Science are Bengali, Gujarati, Marathi, Kannada and Telugu. (*see Table 1*)

NTM Survey: Knowledge Texts Scenario Survey (KTS Survey) by NTM shows that knowledge texts on Political Science are being produced in regional languages in various ways. Original writings on Political Science in regional languages are more. Some of the classics in Political Science have already been translated into some regional languages. Original and translated texts in regional languages have been found in many of the university syllabi. For example, Rajakiya Siddantha and Chintakaru (Political Theory and Thinkers) by Dr. K.J. Suresh is prescribed in B.A. Political Science of Mysore University

It is noticed that apart from government-funded institutes, some private publishers are engaged in the business of bringing out translations/publishing original texts on Political Science in regional languages. More than 15 knowledge texts on Political Science are published in languages like Assamese, Bengali, Marathi, Punjabi, Tamil and others. In languages like Hindi, Kannada and Telugu the number is more than hundred. According to the survey, Political Science is one of the prioritized disciplines that are published among the non-literary texts across the publishing houses in India. These titles are both in original and translation.

UGC Report: According to the UGC report there are forty-three (43) universities where one hundred and three (103) courses of Sociology are taught in regional languages. The courses offered are Diploma (4), UG (11), PG (40), M. Phil. (18), Ph. D. (29) and others (1). Among these 43 universities, there are 22 universities where MoI for Sociology is Hindi. Apart from Hindi, The other regional languages which are used as MoI for Sociology courses are Bengali, Gujarati, Marathi, Kannada, Tamil, Telugu and Tibetan (*See Table 1*)
