National Translation Mission is happy to announce that the training programme postponed earlier is rescheduled from 07 to 21 February, 2024.

Participants selected earlier may kindly confirm their participation on new dates. As informed earlier, the list of selected/ waitlisted candidates remain valid.

In addition to the lectures, this programme includes translation tasks wherein you are expected to translate a small book or an article from English into your language as a **mandatory assignment**. Hence, you must possess the ability to comprehend English texts and express that is in Indian language. If you are not able to do translation, you may kindly withdraw your name, so that some other participant in the wait-list can get a chance to attend the programme.

We request you to check our website regularly for latest updates.

Kindly take note of the following:

1. Selected participants, if not hopeful of joining, may please inform us within two days of receipt of this email, so that the opportunity can be offered to the next participant in the waiting list.
2. The selection is arranged language-wise and it is based on the objective of giving adequate representation to all 22 languages of the VIII Schedule of the Constitution of India.
3. For languages represented by a vast number of applicants, priority was given the following order: In-Service faculty/Professional translator → Research Scholar → Master Degree → Under Graduation.
4. Rs.500/- is to be paid by all participants at the time of reporting. This money is adjustable with two issues of the NTM journal - *Translation Today*.
5. A list of wait-listed candidate will be released by 29 January 2024.
6. A social media group will be created for general instructions and for facilitating frequently asked questions.
7. The candidates are required to book their onward and return journey tickets by III AC train and share the information with us latest by 28 January 2024. If travelled by higher class or flight, their fares will be restricted to III AC only.
8. The preferred mode of communication is e-mail. Please write to us on ntmtrainingprog2016@gmail.com
9. No query regarding Travel Allowance (TA) will be entertained at this stage, as the **TA matters are decided on the basis of performance during the programme.**
10. Modest accommodation (free) will be arranged **from February 06 to 21, 2024** on shared basis. No query will be entertained for special accommodation. If it doesn't meet your expectations, you can arrange your stay outside the Institute campus on your own and NTM will **NOT** bear such expenses.
11. Food from **February 07 to 21, 2024** will be arranged (free) by the NTM.
12. Please report on or a day before the programme

13. The venue for the course is the NTM Preview Theatre at the campus.
14. Attendance is compulsory on all days. No participant should discontinue in the middle of the programme
15. Irrespective of your designation at your work place, you will be considered as a participant only. Please do not expect any special favours based on your designation.
16. It is mandatory for the participants to follow the rules of the hostel/institute during your stay. The NTM may initiate disciplinary action if you do not conduct yourself properly.
17. You will get the certificate on successful participation of the programme. Successful participation means (a) Regular attendance (b) Completion of translation assignment (c) Conduct throughout the programme.

We request you to please carry a laptop, as it would be helpful in completing the translation assignments in time.


How to reach Mysore: If you are coming by train from Bangalore Railway Station, get down at Mysore Railway station and take a prepaid auto to Central Institute of Indian Languages which is approximately a distance of 5 Kms). Please check your name and show your identity card with the security at the gate (Voter ID/PAN card/Aadhar or any other identity proof). The security will guide you to the CIIL Hostel, where the NTM has booked your accommodation. Please cross-check your name and sign on the list of participants which will be available with the Hostel office.

If you are coming by bus from Bangalore, go to Satellite bus-stand where you will get the bus towards Mysore. At the Mysore Bus stand, take a prepaid auto to CIIL (Approximate distance is 6 kms.)
