

Prof. Harish Trivedi

Harish Trivedi is a Professor in the Department of English, Delhi University, Delhi.

Prof. Trivedi is a well know scholar of Post-colonialism and Translation Studies.

He has authored *Colonial Transactions: English Literature and India* (Calcutta 1993; Manchester 1995), and has co-edited *The Nation across the World: Postcolonial Literary Representations* (New Delhi 2007), *Literature and Nation: Britain and India 1800-1990* (London 2000), *Post-colonial Translation: Theory and Practice* (London 1999), and *Interrogating Post-colonialism: Theory, Text and Context* (Shimla 1996; rpt. 2000). He guest-edited a special issue of *New Comparison* (U.K.) on "Comparative Literature in India" (Spring 1997), and co-edited an issue of the postcolonial journal *Wasafiri* with "Focus on Translation" (London Winter 2003)

He was a Visiting Professor, University of Chicago, U.S.A., Spring 1999 Leverhulme Visiting Professor, School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London, 2002-03.

He was also the Commonwealth Scholar, University of Wales, Bangor, U.K., 1971-75. Honorary Research Fellow, University of Birmingham, U.K., 1985-88. Visiting International Scholar, University of Georgia, U.S.A., 1997.

Prof. Harish Trivedi was Secretary (1993-99) and Vice-President (1999-) of the Indian Association for Commonwealth Literature and Language Studies. Vice - Chair of the [International] Association for Commonwealth Literature and Language Studies, 2002-2004.

He has delivered lectures at the University of California Berkeley, the University of Georgia at Athens, the University of Oklahoma, the University of Chicago (a series of four lectures), the University of Alberta at Edmonton, the Murdoch, Curtin, Melbourne and Wollongong universities (all Australia), the University of Oxford, University of Cambridge, the University of Ghent, and the University of Palermo.
